## Environmental Policy

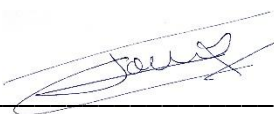
Luvata Welwyn garden Ltd is committed to protecting the local and global environment of the earth. To minimize environmental impacts concerning our activities, products and services, we shall:
